

BRIEFING 13

Environmental Controls

We work to protect the environment and our neighbours. Everyone on site must help prevent pollution and manage waste responsibly.

Pollution prevention

- Store fuels, oils and chemicals in bunded areas, away from drains.
- Know the location of the spill kit and how to use it; report all spills.
- Never allow silty water, concrete washout, fuel or chemicals to enter drains or watercourses.
- Switch off plant and vehicles when not in use to reduce emissions.

Waste & housekeeping

- Segregate waste into the correct skips; do not contaminate recyclables.
- Keep hazardous waste separate and clearly labelled.
- Damp down or cover materials to control dust; minimise mud on the road.

Neighbours & nuisance

- Keep noise within agreed working hours and limits.
- Avoid unnecessary running of engines and generators.
- Keep the site boundary and public areas clean.

STOP & ASK If you see a spill reaching a drain or watercourse, act on it immediately with the spill kit and report it to the site manager.
