First Aid Arrangements

Antvic provides trained first-aiders and stocked first-aid facilities on every site. Make sure you know who and where they are.

If someone is injured

- Make the area safe — do not put yourself at risk.
- Call the site first-aider; do not move a seriously injured person unless they are in danger.
- For a serious injury call 999 and inform the site manager immediately.
- Stay with the casualty and reassure them until help arrives.

First-aid facilities

- The first-aid point and kit location are shown on the site plan and signage.
- An accident book / report form is kept with the first-aid kit.
- Names and contact details of first-aiders are displayed on the site notice board.

Your responsibilities

- Know the name and location of your nearest first-aider before you start.
- Report every injury — however minor — so it is recorded and treated.
- Do not remove items from first-aid kits for non-first-aid use.

STOP & ASK All injuries must be recorded, including minor cuts and near misses that could have caused harm.
