

BRIEFING 01

Site Rules & Conduct

Every person on an Antvic site must follow the site rules at all times. These rules keep you, your colleagues and the public safe. Breaches may result in removal from site.

Core site rules

- Sign in on arrival and sign out when you leave — every visit, no exceptions.
- Complete the site induction before your first visit; carry a valid CSCS card.
- Wear the required PPE for the whole time you are on site.
- Work only within the area and task covered by your approved RAMS.
- Keep walkways, stairs and exits clear; tidy as you go.
- Obey all signs, barriers and exclusion zones.

Behaviour & conduct

- Zero tolerance of alcohol and drugs — anyone unfit to work will be removed.
- No horseplay, fighting, threatening behaviour or harassment of any kind.
- No unauthorised use of plant, tools or equipment.
- Mobile phones must not be used while operating plant or near moving machinery.
- Smoking and vaping only in designated areas.

Your responsibilities

Look after your own safety and that of others. Report unsafe conditions, damaged equipment or rule breaches to your supervisor immediately. If you are unsure of a rule, ask before you act.

STOP & ASK If you are asked to do something that is not in your RAMS, or that feels unsafe, stop and speak to the site manager first.
